

HOW TO CARE PROPERLY FOR MERINO WOOL

Merino wool has antibacterial properties that help prevent the buildup of odor-causing bacteria and manages moisture perfectly. Instead of washing after each wear, you can use these merino features to maintain and refresh your Merino wool clothing:

- 1. **Air Out**: After wearing your Merino wool garment, hang it up in a well-ventilated area, the best is humid, to air out. This can help eliminate any lingering odors and freshen the fabric.
- 2. **Spot Clean**: If you notice a small stain or spill, spot clean the affected area using a mild detergent and water or just water. Gently blot the stain without rubbing to avoid damaging the fibers.
- 3. **Rotate Your Garments**: Give your Merino wool clothing a break between wears. Alternating between different pieces allows them to recover their shape and stay fresh.
- 4. **Follow Odor Cues**: Trust your sense of smell. If you feel your Merino wool garment is starting to develop a noticeable odor, it's time to give it a wash.

Remember that individual preferences and activities may vary, so you can adjust the frequency of washing based on your comfort level and how much you've worn the garment.



MASCHINE WASH

In any case, when washing is necessary, follow these steps:

- 1. **Check the Care Label:** Always check the care label on your merino wool garment for specific washing instructions.
- 2. Close any zippers and racks before you put your clothes into wash machine: Merino wool is delicate fibre and zippers and racks can pull off the fibre and damage your garment. Garments with zippers and racks is also recommend turning them inside out.
- 3. **Turn the ALPBOCK garment Inside Out:** To protect the outer surface of the garment, turn it inside out before placing it in the washing machine.
- 4. **Place in a Mesh Laundry Bag:** To further protect your merino wool item from friction and stretching, consider placing it in a mesh laundry bag or a pillowcase.
- 5. **Use a Gentle Cycle:** If your merino wool item is machine washable, use a washing machine with a gentle or wool cycle. These cycles are designed to minimize agitation and prevent stretching or felting of the fibers.
- 6. Use Cold Water or 30 °C: Set the washing machine to a cold water or 30 °C temperature. Hot water can cause merino wool to shrink, so it's crucial to keep the water temperature as cold as possible.
- 7. **Use a Mild Detergent:** Use a mild, wool-specific detergent or a detergent designed for delicate fabrics. Avoid using regular laundry detergents, as they may contain enzymes, softeners or other products with bleach that can harm the wool fibers.
- 8. **Do not tumble dry rather Dry Flat:** After washing, reshape the garment to its original dimensions and lay it flat to air dry. Avoid hanging merino wool items as this can cause them to stretch. Keep them away from direct sunlight and heat sources.
- 9. **Avoid Wringing or Twisting:** Never wring or twist merino wool garments to remove excess water, as this can damage the fibers.
- 10. **Most of the products from wool or merino does not require to iron** but if needed than Iron Carefully. Always keep the iron on the lowest heat setting.
- 11. **Store Properly:** Avoid using wire hangers, as they can distort the shape of the fabric.

Remember that merino wool is a delicate fiber, and proper care will help maintain its softness, shape, and longevity. When in doubt, it's usually safer to hand wash merino wool items to ensure they remain in excellent condition.
